**Read John 3: 5-8, John 1:12-13, Acts 2:37-39, Luke 3:16, 1 Peter 3:21, Acts 22:16, Mark 16:16, Acts 2:41, Acts 8:12, Acts 11:16, Acts 16:33, John 1:33, Matthew 28:19. Answer the following questions.**

When did the church of Acts baptize a new believer?

Did the early church include baptism in their Gospel proclamations?

What is the new birth and how is baptism a part of it?

What does it mean to be “baptized with the Holy Spirit”?

What are some comparisons and contrasts between baptism and salvation?

From these Scriptures and others, how does modern church baptism compare to the practice of the early church?

In the sermon, I compared baptism to a marriage ceremony, what are your conclusions?

Ask your own questions about these scriptures.
